Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken.

- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 15:33: "Do not be misled: Bad company corrupts good character."
- 4. What does this teach about the friends we choose? How can we avoid compromising our character and good morals?

- 2. What is the third strand described in Ecclesiastes that strengthens our friendships the most?
- 3. How does choosing quality friends benefit us as Christians?
