Set

No amount of working out, eating right or sleep will satisfy our souls, only the Lord.

God is the only one who can give our souls rest and hope. All our strength is because He is strong. Any peace we have is simply because God is peace Himself. All our hope is found only in Christ.

On days when you feel weak, don't look to the world for strength; turn and rely on the One who will always satisfy your soul.
