Application

2. Who receives the crown of life and when is it rewarded?
3. Who in your life has persevered through trials, loves God and seems to be wearing the crown of life? Tell us about him or her.

Connection

1. What are some trials you regularly endure with your team as you compete in sport?
2. What gives you the strength to persevere?
3. How do you know when you have passed the test?

Discovery

List a trial you have recently or are currently facing. Include examples of how you have seen God's hand of blessing as you endured this trial. Pray for the chance to use your experiences to help a teammate "pass the test" during their times of struggle.
