### **Bridge**

1. Romans 12:1-2 is a dynamic scripture for our lives in sport. It can be used to shape our views of sacrifice and the nature of worship. *"Therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your spiritual worship."*
2. Which words describe the kind of sacrifice our bodies are to be?
3. How does such sacrifice amount to spiritual worship?

### **Connection**

1. When do you experience such living sacrifice and worship in your sporting life?
2. When do you get a sense that your athletic sacrifices are holy and pleasing to God?
3. What are some sacrifices that may be required for your team to fulfill its goals this season?

### **Discovery**

Think about what God's role is for you on your team. Is there anything He is asking you to sacrifice to fulfill this role? Make a list of potential obstacles that might hinder your sacrifice and how, with the help of Christ, you can overcome each of them.
