Set

When we are led well, we can perform well. Coaches are called to be leaders and automatically have a team of players dependent on them, looking to them for advice, encouragement, energy, guidance, answers, and an example. A coach's role is vital in an athlete's life, on and off the field, and has significant influence. Without a coach, a team would be lost. But who leads the coach? As your Coach, God has gone ahead of you. He knows what you need. Victory lies in keeping your eyes fixed on Coach Jesus.
