### **Set**

As I write these devotions, I always try to challenge the readers with the questions at the end. I find myself beginning my final questions with "start today" or "today, how can you start..." I want to encourage you to start today making the necessary changes you need to make in order to follow Christ 100 percent. He wants ALL of you, not just the part you are willing to give. He does not promise us tomorrow, either. Start today! Make that change, waking up everyday and living closer to Him than the day before. It is up to you! You will not regret it.

Don't look back. You can't change one thing that happened yesterday, so live in this day! Start right now to live for Him!
