Through triumph and happiness, know there is a Lord wanting to rejoice:

Through ignorance and confusion, know there is a Lord calling your name:

"Jesus answered, 'Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become to him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.'"

Through mistakes and failures, know there is a Lord willing and ready to offer forgiveness:
