As her timer, I questioned whether or not she would be physically able to finish her 100m freestyle, since she seemed to be struggling during her final lap. As I looked around to see if I should go in after her, I noticed the natatorium was getting louder from the cheers of encouragement from fellow swimmers. One by one, they were standing up all around the natatorium, cheering and clapping for her to finish. And she did finish, with a smile on her face. It was that day that I realized the incredible power that God has given us in the form of encouragement.

Today, I challenge you to be the voice of God to encourage and inspire others to great things in Him.
