Set

And everyone who is chasing the world's standards will one day realize that all their efforts to find happiness will end up at the foot of the cross.

Next time you feel caught in the rush of the crowd, turn around and push against it. Head away from evil and straight toward the cross of Christ. Only there can you find joy, happiness and peace. The journey may be tough, but it's totally worth it in the end.
