Bridge

1. Read the following scripture found in I Kings 19:19-21:

“Elijah left there and found Elisha son of Shaphat as he was plowing. Twelve teams of oxen were in front of him, and he was with the twelfth team. Elijah walked by him and threw his mantle over him. Elisha left the oxen, ran to follow Elijah, and said, ‘Please let me kiss my father and mother, and then I will follow you.’

‘Go on back,’ he replied, ‘for what have I done to you?’

So he turned back from following him, took the team of oxen, and slaughtered them. With the oxen’s wooden yoke and plow, he cooked the meat and gave it to the people, and they ate. Then he left, followed Elijah, and served him.”

2. How did Elisha show commitment?
3. What was his commitment level on a 1-10 scale?

1. How are you affected when a teammate demonstrates commitment as strongly as Elisha did?
2. In what ways can you show commitment to your team? How about your relationship with Christ?

Evaluate your commitment level to your team and God. List several principles that shape you as a player and Christian, then commit to praying every day for strength to live them out.
