Set

In Scripture God clearly tells us to persevere, to fix our eyes on Jesus and trust that He will make something good from the situation. The people He has put above us are by His institution, and though it may be difficult to unclench the fists around our hearts, we must open ourselves to hearing from God in new ways through our obedience.

And we *will* hear and grow. Because God often uses what we fight most to disclose more of Himself to us through the process.
