His skin color became red, he stumbled and collapsed on the mat. Several minutes of medical assistance was given. Everyone watched horrified and confused. Sadly, Michael did not survive. It was at this time, I saw Ginny walk to the head table, ask for the microphone and start to speak to the crowd. She told them “Michael believed in Jesus, he knew the Lord, and is now with the Lord in Heaven. He is alright. He is singing with the angels.” Spontaneously, a subtle but sure sound of applause was heard throughout the arena.

Sunday, the final day of competition, we were praying for Michael’s family. During the day, Ginny noticed a woman following her. That evening as the team boarded the bus for the last time, the woman pulled Ginny aside. We waited. Finally, Ginny joined us. The woman told her that what Ginny had said changed the people of Kouvola. God’s message had been delivered.

I learned that day that no matter what space we may step into, God is with us. That no matter what tragic event happens, God’s plan is always on track and in the forefront. I learned that God is always in control and never leaves our side. As you compete on your field of play today, remember, have faith—God is with us.
