The eyes of the Lord are everywhere, observing the wicked and the good. The tongue that heals is a tree of life, but a devious tongue breaks the spirit.” – Proverbs 15:1-4

Billy Graham famously said, “A coach will impact more people in one year than the average person will in an entire lifetime.” Coaches have influence, and their words carry weight.
